Mayflower Members In order to qualify for the members' rate, you must be a Mayflower member or chapter member in good standing as of December 31, 2016

Fees: \$725

Payment options: one payment of \$725 or two payments - \$400 cheque dated April 15 2017 and \$325 cheque dated June 15, 2017

Registrations should not be postmarked earlier than April 15 2017

Non-Mayflower Members

Fees: \$810 Payment options: one payment of \$810 or two payments - \$500 cheque dated May 1 2017 and \$310 cheque dated June 15 2017

Registrations should not be postmarked earlier than May 1 2017

To register please return the completed form along with your full registration fee. If you are paying with two cheques, both must be included with your registration form.

Cheques or money orders will be accepted. Registrations from outside Canada must be paid with a money order in Canadian funds.

\$75 of the registration fee is non-refundable. After August 15 2017 none of the fee is refundable unless you find a replacement. Registration will be considered by postmark dates on a first come, first serve basis!
