Thread Vessels

Simple, elegant, enchanting....
 Create delicate, lace thread vessels constructed with thread and/or fabric scraps using a domestic sewing machine. Students will use threads, sizoflor, and a water soluble stabilizer to make a thread sandwich, this is then stitched together using free motion quilting stitches. Once the stabilizer is dissolved, the resulting thread creation is moulded to a shape to make a thread vessel.
 This workshop is suitable for beginner to experienced stitchers.

Kit Fee \$10.00 - water soluble stabilizer and sizoflor will be provided

Supplies

- sewing machine, must be able to drop feed dogs
- fabric scissors, straight pins, rotary cutter & mat
- free motion quilting foot/darning foot
- a colourful assortment of threads/bring threads of different weights and saved up bits of thread
- a couple bobbins
- fabric scraps - these will be used to make fabric confetti
- sewing machine embroidery hoop
